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# THE LOGO

## About the logo and its meaning

### Rationale

MountResilience aims to support European mountain regions and communities in increasing their climate change adaptation (CCA) capacity.

With a very simple representation of a mountain with a tree for its shadow or reflection, the MountResilience logo aims to represent the mountain ecosystems as well as highlight the importance of nature based solutions in this project.

The style of the icon and the type – simple, bold, solid – was chosen to represent Resilience.



# THE LOGO

## Logo colour variations



### Main logo

This is the default version of the logo, to be used on white or light backgrounds.



### Black

This version of the logo is to be used on black and white layouts or documents, on light backgrounds.



### Negative

This version of the logo is to be used on colored backgrounds and photographs. Be careful that the logo needs to stand out against the background.

# THE LOGO

## Minimum size and safe area

### Minimum sizes

The minimum size is indicated by the width of the logo. The logo should never be smaller than the minimum indicated sizes to avoid compromising its visibility.

The height of the logo should never be smaller than 10 mm in print or 30 px in digital media.



### Safe area

Keep all other graphic elements, logos or margins at a minimum distance as defined by the "Safe area" line. That minimum distance is based on the width of the icon. The minimum space to the sides of the logo is equal to the width of the icon, while the minimum space above and below the logo is equal to 3/4 of the width of the icon.



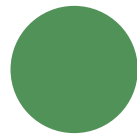

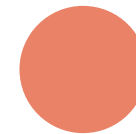
